Figure 1 shows a person sitting on the floor with a blue sling and red straps. Figure 2 shows a person sitting in a wheelchair with a blue sling and red straps. Figure 3 shows a person sitting on a toilet with a blue sling and red straps.

The sling is used to support a person who is unable to sit independently. The sling is placed over the person's legs and buttocks, and the person is then lowered into the chair or wheelchair. The sling is then secured with the red straps, and the person is supported by the chair or wheelchair.

Instructions:

- The sling should be placed over the person's legs and buttocks.
